

School Education Programme

Key Stage 2 (Primary Schools)

This is a four-hour module in the Museum, running from 10:00 until 14:00 catering for groups of up to 30 pupils, consisting of:

- **History of Flight**

A visual presentation covering man's first flight to the present day

- **How Things Fly**

A presentation with props to illustrate the technology of flight aimed at a younger audience

- **Navigation**

An exercise using compass', an interactive game and the facility to watch aircraft fly from the adjacent Gloucester Airport

- **Paper Plane**

A workshop making paper planes learning from the technology of flight talk

- **Lunch**

In the picnic area or café dependant on weather (not provided by the Museum)

- **Guided Tour**

In groups of 5/6 a guided tour of the museum exhibits

Key Stage 3 (Secondary Schools)

This is a four-hour module in the Museum, running from 10:00 until 14:00 catering for groups of pupils studying GCSE's.

A combination of presentations and practical workshops including:

- An Introduction to Aircraft and Technology
- Aircraft, Flight and controls
- Engines, Jet and propellers
- Building a plane
